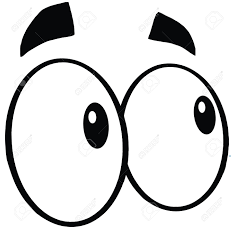

Overlooked marriages & deaths notices

Abstracts from the *Wilmington Journal* weekly 1844-1847, a continuing series from the previous *Clarendon Courier*. These notices identified as OVERLOOKED after discovering them left out from other publications featuring mid-19th century *Wilmington* newspapers.

Wilmington Journal weekly Friday 6 June 1845 page 3

MARRIED—In this county, on the 29th ult., by **Alexander McRae**, Esq., Mr. **John Hansley** to Miss **Caroline Mott**, daughter of Mr. **Benjamin Mott**.

M— In Nashville, N. C., on the 8th ult., Dr. **T H Scott**, formerly of Raleigh, to Miss **Mary E**, daughter of **Lawrence Battle**, dec'd, of Nashville.

DIED—In this town, on the 3d inst., **Leonora**, daughter of **R J** and **Ann E Jones**, aged 2 months and two weeks.

D—In Carter county Tenn., on the 4th ult., in the 40th year of her age, Mrs. **Margaret A Sumner**, relict of the late **David E Sumner**, Esq., of Hertford county, and daughter of the late Chief Justice **Taylor** of N. C.

TO THE PUBLIC, **Francis Jones**, recently died in the Parish of Iberville, Louisiana, leaving no heirs and considerable property. Mr **Jones** was a native of *Wilmington* and died at an advanced aged. 27 May 1845 D FULTON

D—In Cumberland county, on the 5th inst., Mrs. **Jane McCrummen**, wife of Mr. **Roderick McCrummen**.

D—In Anson county, **Wm German**, a soldier of the Revolution, in the 87th year of his age.
